Dallas's Weather

Dallas is the third most populous city in the state of Texas and is known for its barbecue, authentic Mexican, and Tex-Mex cuisine! Dallas has a humid sub-tropical climate with distinct four seasons. During the months of September through December the temperatures generally average around 79 degrees F during the day and 56 degrees F at night! In October there may be a shower or two in the forecast, so plan to bring your umbrella. Also, because of the day and evening temperature variation, you may want to bring a light coat to wear in the evenings or inside the rooms at the conference.

DFW Airport Transportation

<u>Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW) Airport Transportation</u> to <u>Crowne Plaza Dallas</u>

The Crowne Plaza Dallas is accessible to/from Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW) Airport (19 miles, minimum 30-minute commute) using several modes of ground transportation including <u>Taxi</u>, <u>Airport Shuttle</u>, <u>Car Rental</u>, <u>Uber</u>, <u>Lyft</u>, <u>WINGZ</u>, <u>Rail</u>, and <u>City Bus</u>.

Taxi Transportation Services

Taxi services from Dallas-Fort Worth (DFW) Airport can be accessed on the upper level of Terminals A, B, C and E; and on the lower level of Terminal D. For taxi information, call 972-973-4062 or visit the website and click on <u>Taxis</u>. We recommend allowing an hour for taxi transportation from DFW Airport to the Crowne Plaza Hotel near the Galleria in Addison, Texas.

Getting Around Dallas

The SCSUG 2017 Educational Forum will be held at the Crowne Plaza Dallas near the Galleria in Addison, Texas. There are several modes of transportation for getting around the area.

- M-Line Trolley To get around Uptown and the Arts District for "free", hop on the M-Line Trolley that runs the length of McKinney Avenue between Blackburn and St. Paul streets.
- <u>D-Link</u> This is another "free" transportation service provided by Dallas Area Rapid Transit. D-Link is a "free" shuttle that runs throughout all of downtown and into the Bishop Arts District in Oak Cliff. Buses run every 15-minutes, Monday Saturday from 11:00 AM to 11:30 PM.
